

Within the Public Call for Support to the Development of Introductory Project Activities of Project Proposals, within the programme / project "Partnership for Rural Revitalization" implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management in cooperation with the United Nations Development Program, UNDP) Village realized the introductory activity "**Preparation of project - technical documentation necessary for the construction of the Eco-ethno camp**".



With the support of the Environmental Protection Fund of the Municipality of Bor, AC Village recorded 60 educational shows on environmental protection called "**Ecological Alphabet**". The shows were made for children in the lower grades of primary schools, so the CDs with the shows were donated to all primary schools in Bor, as well as TV Bor and TV Sesame, which received permission from the Village to show them.
